

BONHOEFFER STUDY TOUR

14-24 MAY 2010

Visit Germany, Poland and the Czech Republic and see the major sites important in Bonhoeffer's life and work.

Stops on the tour include his birth place, boyhood home, university attended, archives in Berlin, pastorates, Confessing Church seminary which he directed, the monastery where he stayed during his involvement with the conspiracy against Hitler, and prison and concentration camps where he was incarcerated and executed. Places to be visited include Berlin, Zingst, Finkenwalde, Köslin, Breslau, Auschwitz, Prague, Flossenbürg, Regensburg, Munich, and Ettal.
